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**Lýsing / Course description:**

The course material focuses on advanced vocabulary, theme-based texts, the memoir *Born a Crime* by Trevor Noah and a selection of short stories by different authors. The course provides various other writing, speaking, reading, and listening exercises. *Students are expected to bring a laptop to every class and use English in the classroom.*

The aim of this course is to help students to further develop their abilities to...

- work independently and in groups on assignments in English.
- discuss different ideas in texts, video and audio materials.
- write systematically about various topics and improve their argumentative writing skills.
- summarize and paraphrase texts and videos, both in speaking and writing.
- increase their knowledge of syntax, grammar, and punctuation.
- extend their vocabulary; academic (AWL), SAT/TOEFL, and general with various texts and exercises.
